- BOMA One's Strategic Plan is complete.
   Our Board will use this as part of the framework to develop and finalize our Chapter's strategic plan.
- BOMA International approved amending Section 168 of the Internal Revenue Service Code to provide a shorter, more realistic period for depreciation of commercial roofs to 20 years. It was 39 years.
- "Buildings" magazine, a publication of Stamats Business Media located in Cedar Rapids, IA, and BOMA International, joined an alliance to own, manage and promote the BOMA Office Building Show, beginning with the 2007 trade show in New York City.
- The conference offered a large array of top-quality education sessions. There were 35 educational seminars over the course of 3 days.
- Two well-known headliners spoke at the general sessions. Firstly, the bestselling author Malcom Gladwell presented "Blink." In Blink, Gladwell analogized the split-second intuitive judgment used in successful decision-making. 
